What is taiko?

-Taiko is the Japanese word for drum. We also use it for the art of Japanese drumming.

-In Japan, children's taiko groups are very popular.

Why will my child enjoy taiko?

-Taiko is a high energy and physical activity that combines music and choreography. Children love the big sound and flashy playing style.

-The classes will also apply aspects of Japanese language and culture, such as counting, bowing in and out of class, command and cheer words, as well as Japanese verbal music notation.

Is my child's hearing at risk?
